a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To extend the sewer system to Northwest Florida Community Hospital, the only hospital in this Rural Area of Opportunity (RAO), to ensure that adequate healthcare can continue to be provided. The existing sewer service is inadequate and improperly located to support the expansion of the hospital. The project will also serve houses and existing businesses that will be able to better access this newly provided sewer capability.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The existing sewer system will be extended to serve a larger area in this Rural Area of Opportunity (RAO)

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Enhanced sewer capabilities that ensure adequate healthcare to Northwest Florida Community Hospital and houses and existing businesses in the area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the people around the Northwest Florida Community Hospital; many individuals are expected to benefit from this expansion

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Improved physical health; measured by greater access to healthcare. Enhanced environmental quality; measured by a reduction in nitrate and number of septic tank systems. Protect the general public from harm; measured by an observance of less failures and spills. Improved wastewater management; measured by additional homes and businesses to be serviced. Improve groundwater quality; measured by the number of septic tank systems removed. Improve drinking water quality; measured by number of septic tank systems removed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If appropriated, the City of Chipley will ensure that all deliverables and performance measures set forth in the funding agreement are met. These measures will include engaging a compliance/project management team to work with City staff to oversee administration and compliance of the appropriated funds.
