14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will be used to construct a second wastewater force main to convey wastewater from the island to the City of Venice Eastside Water Reclamation Facility (EWRF). If the existing force main were to fail, break, clog, or be damaged by a hurricane, the consequences to the environment and island residents would be catastrophic. The second sewer line would limit the risks, provide reliability, and improve the level of service to the residents, businesses, restaurants, and tourists of Venice while protecting the environment.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The funds would be used for the construction of the city's Intracoastal Waterway Force Main. The city will install approximately 2000 feet of 12-inch pipe from Florida St. (west side of the bridge) under the intracoastal waterway to Warfield Ave. (east side of the bridge) and connect to the existing city's sewer collection system.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The purpose of this project is to make sure our citizens living on the island and visitors staying on the island can convey their wastewater from the island to the city's wastewater plant. The only way to minimize the risk of the wastewater system not being able to convey the wastewater from the island is to add the redundant wastewater force main so that, for any reason that one force main is not operational, there is a second line that can convey the wastewater from the island.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximate 6,000 island residents, businesses, restaurants, downtown shops, and visitors on the island will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of the Intracoastal Waterway Second Force Main is to provide redundancy, enhance reliability by having an alternate route to convey wastewater from the island, and protect the environment from any raw wastewater spills.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Additional engineering reports will determine what is needed to meet the deliverables. If deliverables cannot be completed, then the return of the funds will be necessary.
