This is a limited infrastructure project that will allow for expanded wastewater treatment near Vortex Spring.

This project will serve the 1,000+ tourists, Florida residents, and locals that visit Vortex Spring each year. Citizens in western Holmes County will be benefited by the anticipated economic growth in the area currently on hold due to public wastewater needs.
