Excessive speeding and poor peak operational level of service put lives at risk and other adverse impacts. The goal is to place a roundabout at this location to slow vehicle speeds, improve multimodal safety, create efficient traffic flow, and reduce pollution and fuel use, and save maintenance costs.
