Improved Incident Response: Real-time monitoring through CCTV cameras, coupled with intrusion detection systems, will enable swift incident response, minimizing potential damage and downtime.

Heightened Security: Strengthened defense mechanisms will significantly reduce the risk of data breaches, ensuring the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of our information assets.

Enhanced Compliance: By implementing stringent access controls and conducting regular audits, we will align our cybersecurity practices with industry standards and regulatory requirements, ensuring compliance and fostering trust among stakeholders.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through heightened security and improved incident response, the city would be able to more appropriately dispense mitigation assets to reduce the response times and mitigate the loss of critical infrastructure.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A reduction in permanent damages to critical infrastructure. A lowered chance of exposure of PII and other private information that is stored on city servers and other systems. There is the potential of a reduction in services cost that is passed on to the citizens and businesses of Wilton Manors.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The residents and businesses of Wilton Manors.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Through elevated security awareness, it is expected that the employee team serving Wilton Manors will be in a better position to identify security threats before they become a problem. Through the combination of other methodologies such as regular penetration testing and audit log reviews, the security team can shift electronic mitigation resources to the front that is most appropriate. This will eliminate the practice of the "spray and pray" approach to cybersecurity. This would shift costs down and to the appropriate areas.

Failure to meet deliverables and/or performance measures as specified in the contract will result in loss of state funding.
