The existing generator is over 16 years old and required constant attention and maintenance to keep operational. Current generator is 250Kw and is undersized for the new expasions of the Water Treatment Facilty. Due to this the local well head (Well 4) and ugrades to the nano treatment facility cannot produce water in the event of loss of power. When this event happens the water pumping system that maintains required pressure through the distribution system is also compromised. Too add the required chemical injection componants to maintain safe quality of potable water are also effected.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Contractual services for engineering/project management, administrative and construction services of a 350 Kw generator with an outdoor rated enclosure and concrete pad. The Generator will require an automatic transfer switch, power distribution modifications, additions to tie-in with current electrical distribution and required additional circuitry for onboard battery charger and block heater.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Bowling Green WTP provides Potable water service to 2940 persons. When emergencies and natural disasters happen that result in a loss of power to the facility. The potable water system can be compromised and cause issues to pubic health due to inability to maintain applicable primary and secondary standards.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The expected benefit is the entire populaation of the City of Bowling Green. The Bowling Green WTP provides Potable water service to 2940 persons.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

As per F.A.C. 62-555.320 (14) (a) systems shall provide standby power for systems serving more than 350 persons. A upgrade to more modern standby power system will be needed to meet the requirements of F.A.C. To protect the system's water source, treatment, and pumping facilities necessary to deliver drinking water meeting all applicable primary or secondary standards at a rate at least equal to the average daily water demand for the system.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Construction disbursments would not be made if construction of the project is not completed.
