14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The City of Bartow's (City) goal is to protect, save lives and property by designing and building a new fire rescue station on City-owned property that addressees growth in residential and commercial development. In a 2010 3rd-party study 3 new fire station locations were recommended to address population growth and the increase in square miles from 9 to 53. Increasing fire stations would improve response times, provide proper protection to save lives and property and improve insurance premiums and the ISO rating.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Activities and services will include contractual preliminary engineering, design, permitting bidding, project management, engineering during construction, land acquisition and construction services for a new Fire Rescue Station through the procurement policy and procedures.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services will include faster and more efficient response to 911 emergency calls. Citizens will benefit with a new fire station because response times will improve; allows for efficient and effective public safety operations, improve emergency operations and improve insurance premiums and the ISO rating. This is a critical investment in the safety and well-being of first responders, residents, visitors, students, business community and of the numerous local State and Federal government facilities.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Bartow which serves as the County seat for Regional, Federal and State offices, agencies, properties and buildings, which are tax exempt creating a reduction of revenue that is needed to adequately serve its citizenry and surrounding communities. It is estimated more than 19,477 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Citizens will benefit with a new fire station because response times will improve; allows for efficient and effective public safety operations to include emergency operations and improve insurance premiums and the ISO rating. This is a critical investment in the safety and well-being of first responders, residents, visitors, students, business community and of the numerous local State and Federal government facilities.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Contractual milestones established throughout project, implementation of corrective action plan, non-payment of invoices until milestones completed.
