Hardee County, which is a financially disadvantaged community (ch. 62-552, F.A.C.) that is located in a Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes), citizenry, visitors, tourists, business community and surrounding areas. Greater than 27,000 expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefit is a completed Utilities Master Plan that forecasts future demands by analyzing consumption trends, growth patterns and technological advancements to be ready to serve generations to come; identifying, mapping and addressing connection of water/waste-water service for the remainder of Wauchula Hills community and moving forward to augment and support FDEP and SWFWMD, Peace River Basin Plan and water quality standards for the Peace River and Charlotte Harbor Estuary Basins.
