The Y is committed to serving families by fostering a positive learning experience that allows children to thrive and families to have access to quality-affordable care and programs. The Y's goal is to educate children, so they become confident, socially responsible, and prepared to excel in their futures from kindergarten into adulthood.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services include childcare, educational instruction, food program, enrichment activities, scholarships assistance, family engagement, community gatherings, youth sports, teen activities, summer camp, before and after school care, and healthy living classes.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

YMCA of Southwest Florida's Early Learning program serves early learning six weeks to five years old. This facility will also provide programs that reach seniors, community members struggling with food insecurity, families, and youth of all ages.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Positive outcomes include students (90%) meeting or exceeding expectation in literacy and math as well as developmental milestones including communication skills, fine and gross motor, social-emotional development, and problem solving. Reducing food insecurity for low-income families and educating all community members about healthy living. Curbing the summer learning loss for at-risk students. Reducing childhood obesity through youth sports and other healthy living activities. Bringing the community together. Helping the workforce with before and after school care and early learning academy. Providing a safe, healthy, learning environment for all youth. Providing a welcoming place for seniors. Our Y will work with the City of Arcadia and the Speer Center participants through regular surveys and testing to ensure these outcomes.
