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With committed partnership from the City of Pensacola, the funds for the feasibility study will serve as the kick starter to offer Escambia County school-aged children the chance at a unique and world-class education, along with working with the Department of Education for research, demonstration and evaluation.

The Study will characterize needs for faculty, aptitude testing mechanisms, curricula, advisory board/council, policies, community needs, funding needs and opportunities, and state and federal policies.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, homeless, grade school students, and University/College students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Currently, Escambia County's high school graduation rate ranks lower than the national average. By offering a new and innovative school curricula tailored to the needs of the community, the UWF Lab School will improve education outcomes for its students.
