14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This initiative seeks to create a robust, redundant data backup solution for the First Judicial Circuit's digital records, ensuring that, in the event of a ransomware attack, critical court data remains unaltered and available for restoration. This safeguard ensures quick recovery of court operations and significantly reduces the risk to the rule of law, and public trust posed by cybersecurity breaches.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The activity will be the provision of a secure and redundant data backup solution that ensures quick and reliable restoration of digital court records, reducing the risk of data loss from ransomware that can affect legal proceedings and personal affairs.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct service provided is the ability of the court system to quickly resume normal operations after a cyber incident, ensuring minimal disruption to services that citizens rely on, such as trials, hearings, and processing of legal documents.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All court users of the First Judicial Circuit of Florida - in Escambia, Santa Rosa, Okaloosa, Walton counties.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Resilient Judicial Operations: The ability of the court system to quickly resume normal operations after a ransomware attack.

Projected Downtime Reduction: Calculate the reduction in overall downtime experienced by the court system before and after the implementation of the backup solution. The measure is the decrease in downtime after a ransomware attack with a more robust backup solution installed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

A contract will not be executed. Funds will be used to purchase two Dell PowerProtect Cyber Recovery Systems to ensure that critical court data can be recovered in case of a cyber attack.
