#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The organization provides access to legal resources and services to the underserved population and those with limited resources. The program will assist this demographic with certain non-criminal matters. Services include providing legal advice, filing pleadings or responses, and/or assistance at trial or administrative matters. By providing legal based knowledge and services to the underserved, the organization seeks to receive more favorable outcomes within the aforementioned service area.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Community based initiatives, bringing attorneys and resources to the underserved communities, providing panels and discussion forums to educate and inform residents, offering flexible schedules to ensure persons of varying needs are accommodated, offering multiple access points via social media, video/teleconference and in person support, and assisting with legal matters and litigation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Attorneys and staff will provide pro bono legal services to the citizens assisting them in certain legal matters within the scope of the program. Trained attorneys will offer counseling and legal support in the practice of law. Citizens will have an advocate for their pending matter and access to services and resources of the organization.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population to be served are elderly persons, persons with poor mental health, persons with poor physical health, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at-risk youth, homeless, developmentally disabled, physically disabled, high school, and university/college students. We will serve 400-800 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The objective is to provide legal services and representation to those with limited resources and access to said services. It will improve mental health, quality of education, protect general public from harm, economic activity, create specific immediate job opportunities, enhance specific individuals' economic self-sufficiency, and enrich the cultural experience. Part of the program requires measurable deliverables as relates to clients served, cases resolved, and community-based programs/training sessions that have been provided throughout the year, per quarter.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Should any deliverable not be met within the specifications of the agreement, funds are withheld and or reduced from the total allocation in the form of a financial penalty. Should the program not deliver on any deliverable during a period where the organization has received an advanced payment, a potential advance payment repayment penalty is also available at the discretion of the contracting agency.
