Funding will be used by Jewish day schools and pre-schools to pay for contracted security services, transportation services, and target hardening like bullet proof glass, security doors, electronic access, and alarm and camera systems.

Jewish day schools and pre-schools will provide more security for their students, teachers, staff and parents. With the state funds, schools are working to deter, detect, delay and defend themselves, and review on a regular basis if they are consistently and constantly doing what it takes to accomplish this.
