c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Design and Construct 17 New RV concrete pads and hook-ups with 50-amp service. Design and Construct an ADA pavilion. Design and Construct an ADA bathhouse with solar panels for heating water and heating the bathhouse during winter. Design and construct ADA sidewalks from parking to restrooms, proposed pavilion, and other areas. Design and construct a new septic system.

All demographical groups will benefit from this project. More than 45,000 individuals are expected to be served.
