#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

HomeStart embodies a visionary approach to addressing homelessness by recognizing the interconnectedness of stable housing and meaningful employment. By providing a supportive environment that allows clients to focus on skill development while maintaining secure housing, we aim to equip individuals with the tools they need to regain control of their lives. Through strategic partnerships, personalized support, and a commitment to long-term success, HomeStart has the potential to transform the lives of those experiencing homelessness, ultimately leading to greater self-sufficiency and a brighter future. Together, we can create a community where everyone has the opportunity to thrive.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The HomeStart project will utilize the allocated funds to implement a range of activities and services aimed at achieving its intended purpose:

Transitional Housing and Shelter Services: The funds will be used to acquire, renovate, and maintain properties for transitional housing facilities. These spaces will provide safe and stable accommodations for individuals experiencing homelessness.

Job Training and Vocational Programs: The project will offer specialized job training and vocational programs tailored to the needs and interests of participants. This may include skills development workshops, vocational courses, and handson training in collaboration with local industries.

Employment Placement and Support: HomeStart will allocate resources to facilitate job placement for participants, working closely with local businesses and industries to identify suitable employment opportunities. Ongoing support services will also be provided to ensure job retention and career advancement.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project is those who are experiencing homelessness in Central Florida as well as those at risk of homelessness. These populations include families with children as well as recently incarcerated and at risk youth.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of the HomeStart project is to empower citizens experiencing homelessness to regain stability, secure employment, and achieve greater self-sufficiency. The ultimate goal is to break the cycle of homelessness and provide individuals with the tools and resources they need to lead independent, fulfilling lives. Methodology for Outcome Measurement:

Housing Stability: The project will measure the percentage of participants who successfully transition from transitional housing to permanent, stable housing. This will be tracked through regular assessments and follow-ups with participants.

Employment Placement and Retention: The success of the project in facilitating job placement will be measured by tracking the percentage of participants who secure employment within a specified time frame. Additionally, the retention rate in employment will be monitored to assess the sustainability of participants' job placements.
