14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To rehabilitate the existing reclaimed water storage ponds and convert from passive storage to active Ammonia, nitrogen removal, thereby improving the discharge product to improve with the current plant and to enable a possible Beneficial discharge designation once the Consent Order required new plant is built.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The project will encompass the procurement of advanced water treatment technologies and the engagement of specialized contractors to facilitate the conversion process. This will involve the installation of equipment and systems for active ammonia and nitrogen removal, enhancing the efficiency of the water treatment process within the existing plant.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens will primarily involve the delivery of improved water quality. By upgrading the reclaimed water storage ponds and implementing advanced treatment measures, the project aims to enhance the discharge product, aligning with the standards set by regulatory bodies. This not only benefits the community by ensuring a safer and cleaner water supply but also sets the stage for a potential Beneficial Discharge designation once the new plant mandated by the Consent Order is constructed.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is all the residents within the City of Arcadia and the surrounding areas. Approx. 9,000 people.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome of this project is a significant improvement in water quality, meeting or surpassing regulatory requirements. This will contribute to the overall environmental health of the region and lay the groundwork for achieving Beneficial Discharge status. To measure the success of the project, key performance indicators such as pollutant levels, water clarity, and adherence to regulatory standards will be continuously monitored and assessed through a rigorous methodology involving regular testing and reporting protocols.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The suggested penalties for failing to meet deliverables are Penalties may include financial deductions proportional to the shortfall, a structured improvement plan with specified timelines, and, if persistent, termination of the contract.
