#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The requested funds will specifically facilitate the establishment of a comprehensive aviation career and technical education program at Charlotte High School. This program will be achieved by constructing a new airplane hangar, providing students with hands-on learning experiences and real-world exposure to the aviation industry. The program aims to prepare students for high-skill, high-wage jobs in the aviation sector, enhancing their employability and career prospects in a growing industry.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The new aviation career and technical education program at Charlotte High School, supported by the requested funds, will encompass a variety of activities and services. Central to this initiative is constructing an airplane hangar for hands-on aviation training. Students will benefit from the expertise of a highly trained aviation instructor and use industry-standard tools and equipment, facilitating real-world learning experiences. The program focuses on providing training that leads to industry certifications, ensuring students are well-prepared for high-skill, high-wage jobs in the aviation industry. This comprehensive approach integrates real-world scenarios and industry best practices into the curriculum, aligning education with the demands of the aviation sector.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The aviation career and technical education program at Charlotte High School will provide citizens with direct services that enhance educational and employment opportunities. Students will have access to hands-on learning experiences in a newly constructed airplane hangar, utilizing industry-standard equipment. This practical training is supplemented by professional instruction from an experienced aviation educator, preparing students for high-skill, high-wage jobs in the aviation industry. Additionally, the program will offer industry certifications, enhancing the employability of graduates and contributing to the local talent pipeline in a growing sector. These services collectively aim to improve individuals' economic self-sufficiency and support the community's broader economic development.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population served by this aviation career and technical education program at Charlotte High School are high school students within Charlotte County. The program is open to any Charlotte County student interested in pursuing a high-paying career in the growing aviation industry in Florida. Annually, the program is expected to serve approximately 150 students, providing them with the skills, knowledge, and certifications needed to succeed in the aviation sector. This initiative benefits the students directly involved and supports the broader community by developing a skilled workforce aligned with the industry's needs.

### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The construction of a new airplane hangar at Charlotte High School for the new aviation career and technical education program is expected to prepare around 150 students annually for high-skill, high-wage jobs in Florida's aviation industry. The program's success will be measured by the number of students earning industry certifications, securing aviation industry employment, and their average salaries. This initiative will contribute to the local talent pipeline and regional economic growth, with outcomes assessed by creating new aviation jobs and attracting employers to Charlotte County.
