#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The new high service pump station project is of great need as the City only has one pump to provide water to customers from this location. The pump on it's own is unable to generate demand with fire flow or pressures required dearing peaks. Besides making sure residents and businesses have continuance water, it will ensure adequate fire flow when needed.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The proposed High Service Pump Station would include a total of six pumps on one skid. Four of the pumps would be for typical high service, with thre duty and one back up. With one out of service, there would be a firm capacity of 1,800 gpm at 170 feet of pressure. The two other pumps would be jockey pumps, with one duty and one standby rated for flows from 250 gpm down to approximately 100 gmppm. If there are flow demans within the Citybelow 100 gpm, a recycle line can be installed that would send the water back into the storage tank or into the suction line of the pumps to limit pump cycling.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new High Service Pump Station would ensure the City is able to provide adequate and reliable water services. The City has been experiencing numerous water outages which creates a hardship for our residents, and businesses. It would also ensure we are able to provide required fire flow when needed.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Frostproof Residents, as well as the businesses in the City limits, including schools with grade levels Pre-K to 12th grade. The upgrade would serve approximately 10,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcome is that the City will no longer have frequent wateroutages that lead to boil water notices that leave residents and business without water. When we have a water outage, it leaves our resturants, and businesses in a tough position leading them to have to close down and possible dispose of product they have started to make which is very costly for the business that has chosen to make Frostproof their home.
