a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Provide much needed renovation and hardening of the Highlands County Court house built in 1927. Structural repairs need to be done to the exterior of the oldest part of the building to prevent moisture build up that leads to mold inside the building. The building holds the courts and the clerk of courts.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Court related services will be provided in a clean, safe environment that offers essential court related services in one place that not only meets their needs but is also a working museum of history for the legal workings of Highlands County

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizens will be offered court related services such as court hearings/trials of all types, free legal services, participate in foreclosure sales and participate in teen court in an environment that meets current codes for life safety and protection

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population. The majority of the funds will not benefit no specific group. Over 2,500 people will be assisted annually.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit: The Highlands County Courthouse was built in 1927. An addition was added in 2002. The original building is ornate with brick facing and large ornate windows. Restoration of the brick and windows will restore the facade of the building and provide a safe and sealed facility for court purposes.

Methodology: Construction repair will bring the courthouse back to its glory. Moisture content reduction inside the facility and visual physical repairs on exterior.

Benefit: The general public that uses the courthouse will be provided with a cleaner and safer environment and nice place to do business.

Methodology: The number of people submitting complaints about standing water, uneven flooring and environmental issues.
