Return of funds to state agency

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The Mobile Libraries project (Remote Library Locker System) will allow for convenient access to Seminole County Library materials by offering a pickup and return location within underserved communities that are not proximate to one of Seminole County's five libraries. The Remote Locker will increase access to books and library materials, as well as increase library card registration. The underserved areas include Geneva, Chuluota, Winter Springs, and Heathrow.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The addition of these mobile library units/remote locker systems will offer Seminole County residents, who live in an underserved location, access to county library materials. The lockers will allow for a pickup and return location, thereby increasing access to books and library materials, as well as increase library card registration.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The mobile library units/remote locker systems will offer access to residents in the Geneva, Chuluota, Heathrow, and Winter Springs communities. These areas, as documented in the county's Parks and Recreation Master Plan, are underserved by the county's library services. Residents in these areas do not have community libraries. These mobile units will bring closer access to library services.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents located within the Geneva, Chuluota, Heathrow, and Winter Springs communities; more than 1,000 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will provide the following benefits: Improved access to Seminole County Library System books, electronic materials, and other library services (month-over-month data related to the use of the mobile units).
