b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Complete field improvements to Malone School's Softball field from damage caused by Hurricane Michael and provide

dirt, sod, drainage, dugouts, and bleachers.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The completed project will provide an updated sport field for softball for the players and the families who use the field. The improvements will provide a safer environment for the players and the families.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Each school year the team of 15 players and their families, 80-100 individuals, will utilize the field. The teams from other schools and their families will utilize the field, 500-750 individuals. The entire school will have access to the field for physical education and field days, 635 students and 50 staff and their families for field day. The school is 82% economically disadvantaged, providing a valuable resource to improved quality of life.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Student access to physical activity on an outdoor facility assists with the decrease in overweight students and increases the ability to focus during instructional time, improving learning outcomes that are measured by district and state progress monitoring assessments.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The District will adhere to the provisions of the standard Request for Application form the Florida Department of Education. Failure to meet deliverables will result in restrictions on use of funds and possible reduction in funding.
