With the proposed sewer collection system expansion, local septic tanks can be taken off-line. With the removal of septic tanks, water quality should dramatically improve as these systems are adjacent to St. Andrews Bay. Expansion of the water distribution system expanded into this area will take residents off their potable drinking well system, thus relieving

Construction of improvements include but is not limited to septic tank to low pressure sewer conversion and water line upgrades from well to distribution lines. Costs may also include demolition and management of equipment being replaced/improved. A small portion of funds requested will include design updates, associated permitting and oversight during construction.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improved drinking water quality. Enhances and improves environmental quality by removing waterfront septic systems and replacing with a closed low pressure sewage collection system that would assist in the elimination of sepage of sewage and associated nutrients into St. Andrews Bay.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Panama City residents in the Pretty Bayou and Bayview sections of town.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

With septic to sewage conversion, it is anticipated that there will be better environmental outcomes and improved water quality for residents as well as reduced demand on the Florida Aquifer. These outcomes will be measured by the number of new water connections in the project area and nutrient measurement as well as the number of times public swimming parks are shut down for high fecal coliform levels.
