	CCPS aspires to be a Pre-K -12 district to serve more students across the county. Collier lost 1,000 seats as a result of the pandemic creating a need for high-quality early learning opportunities for all students from a wide range of families. Pre-K is a critical determinant of kindergarten readiness. The appropriation will fund 10 new modular Pre-K classrooms and facility modifications, which will provide access to 160 additional Pre-K seats for families in areas of the community where there is documented need. This will allow 3- and 4-year-old children to attend Pre-K in locations close to their home and zoned elementary school, establishing strong school-home connections from a young age.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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CCPS aspires to be a Pre-K -12 district to serve more students across the county. Collier lost 1,000 seats as a result of the pandemic creating a need for high-quality early learning opportunities for all students from a wide range of families. Pre-K is a critical determinant of kindergarten readiness. Currently, CCPS serves over 600 3/4 year-olds in 35 classrooms. Student access to Pre-K increases learning outcomes and increases the percentage of students who are kindergarten ready.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The installation of 10 new modular Pre-K classrooms and facility modifications (grounds and buildings) on CCPS school sites.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Access to 160 additional Pre-K seats for parents/ families in areas of the community where there is documented need. Allows children to attend Pre-K in locations close to their home and zoned elementary school, strong school-home connections. Providing access to high quality Pre-K for children, parents will have access to parent training topics, early literacy, school readiness.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Provide high-quality early learning education for 160 children (ages 3 to 4 years) to ensure kindergarten readiness.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased Pre-K enrollment and increased student performance on the state's kindergarten readiness measure.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Collier County Public Schools would maintain the program for future years through operational funds.
