4. Project/Program Description

City of Naples - Naples Bay Red Tide/Septic Tank Mitigation Project is a joint partnership between the City of Naples and Collier County to convert 835 failing septic tanks to a centralized sanitary sewer system while enhancing the stormwater system to improve water quality to reduce nutrient loading in the sensitive impaired water of Naples Bay. This is a multi-year project with a total estimated construction cost for the installation of a centralized sanitary sewer system and replacement of existing potable water system of \$56 million (sanitary sewer collections system cost: \$35M). This project location is within the US 41/ Goodlette Road corridor located within unincorporated Collier County, but within the potable water and sanitary sewer service areas of the City of Naples Utilities. The Naples City Council will established a special assessment district to assess the property owners for the capital cost of the new central sanitary sewer system that includes the system design.

Reduction of nutrients in the water quality of the stormwater runoff to Naples Bay. Water quality samples will be collected before and after construction of the sanitary sewer system.
