This appropriation would work concurrently with an FDEP Septic to Sewer Grant allow the city to replace the drinking water lines during the same time they are installing the wastewater lines.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The appropriation will fund planning, design, engineering and construction of the new water lines within the city of LaBelle

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The appropriation will allow for the replacement of the oldest drinking water lines within the city. the project will allow for increased pressure and efficiency with the delivery of drinking water.

Residents and businesses within the oldest section of the city of LaBelle

The benefits of this appropriation include government efficiency by allowing the drinking water line replacement to occur while wastewater line construction is occurring. In addition, the project will allow for increased drinking water efficiency, improved drinking water quality and increase pressure to aid in fire suppression.
