a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds will solely be used to reimburse UF-IFAS to build golf course best management practices certification program participant record keeping and tracking tools including, but not limited to, a registry of persons certified. Additionally, useful on-line training resources will be developed and deployed.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Web-based tools and resources will be developed to track Golf Course BMP Training program participants and to monitor the effectiveness of the program.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Tools and systems will be put into place allowing program participants to remain in compliance with training program requirements.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Golf course employees who will receive training to remain in compliance to preserve ecosystems. Approximately 250 individuals will be trained.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Requested funds will be used to develop professionally scripted and curated content for use in golf course best management practices training and educational programming. Compliance with golf course best management practices help ensure that healthy land-based and aquatic ecosystems are preserved. Water quality monitoring program and input reductions, practices recommended in the BMP certification program, are measured over time through industry benchmarking surveys.
