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To build an elevated warehouse to store various electric and water materials that are critical for the continuity of operations and services rendered to City residents. This equipment, such as switch cabinets, transformers, wire, etc., is essential to resume City electrical services by storing and keeping these supplies on site. A warehouse will prevent equipment from being stored outdoors and deteriorating from exposure to the natural elements of the environment and during natural disasters. By building this new facility, the equipment that is used to restore services after a storm will be protected and available for use.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of an elevated warehouse to store various electric and water materials that are critical for the continuity of operations and services rendered to City residents. By building this new facility, the equipment that is used to restore services after a storm will be protected and available for use.

The direct service to the residents will be the ability of City staff and field crews to respond immediately after a hurricane or other storm event to restore services and continue operations rendered to City residents.
