14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this funding request is to seal the roof of the warehouse that houses The Mustard Seed to prevent further roof damage and extend the usage of the current roof by 20 years. Sealing the roof will ensure that there is no additional damage to the existing roof and will mitigate the need to continue patching leaks.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding provided will apply a high solids silicone coating at a range of 2.3 gallons per 100 square feet to achieve an additional 20 years of use out of the current roof structure.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

While funding for this appropriation will not provide direct services, funding provided will ensure that the roof of the facility is secure, so that no inventory for the furniture and clothing programs are damaged.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The Mustard Seed serves a wide variety of families and children who are low income. While the funding appropriation is not for direct services, the funding will ensure that the roof of the agency will be structurally sound for the 20-year quarantee of the sealant provided.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of this project is the continued structural integrity of the existing roof, and no further damage to the organizations building from leaks that currently happen every hurricane season.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

As this is a capital project, failure to meet deliverables within the allotted time, funds would be returned to the state.
