a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

IMG Academy Foundation, a division of IMG Academy in Bradenton Florida is the owner of public access land at 53rd St. and Bolletieri Blvd, Bradenton, FL. Our goal is to commence the development of a multi-sheet ice hockey facility primarily for public use to service youth hockey training, development, competition, tournaments and events and the launch of an IMG Academy boys and girls ice hockey boarding school and summer camp program.

Funds will be used for the development of an indoor ice hockey venue with multiple sheets of ice to service the public and the prospective launch of an IMG Academy girls and boys youth ice hockey boarding school program and fully accessible youth hockey camps, clinics and events.

Reversion of funds.

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The direct services will include but not be limited to youth hockey training, coaching, development, competition, events and tournaments.

At-risk youth, Grade school students, High school students and University/College students.

Improving physical and mental health by creating a key component in the development of the facility will be dedicated space to deliver athletic and personal development including physical fitness training, mindset training, nutrition and wellness programming. Enrich cultural experience with the development of this facility considers creating opportunities for at risk youth from any/all backgrounds, community groups and other to experience the foundational benefit of structure through sport. Improving the quality of education by providing a destination for education in sport and intentional personal development. Improve transportation conditions by coordinating with the planned construction of the extension of 51st St from 53rd St through the west side of the IMG Academy campus to El Conquistador Parkway. Increase economic opportunity and tourism by creating facilities for youth hockey training and education and destination venues for outside tournaments and events which drives tourism
