Yet serious crimes have increased dramatically in Ybor resulting in sever negative impacts to residents and small businesses. The additional resources requested herein are needed to mitigate these impacts and reduce crime in the area.

Acquisition and integration of technology-assistive law enforcement equipment such as cameras, smart lighting, Blue Light acoustic sensors, community engagement technologies, command/control, and related equipment. Repair and maintenance of capital expenditures described above. Research and data analysis of existing crime sources and law enforcement resources. Enhanced cooperation and operational integration among DABT, FDLE, community stakeholders and municipal and county law enforcement personnel.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Design and implementation of enhanced enforcement operations that target trespassing, loitering, vagrancy, underage drinking, narcotics possession and distribution, Evaluation of hiring law enforcement and military veterans to augment routine and existing resources, evaluation of ordinances and enforcement.
