a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the program is to improve employment and earning prospects by providing adults in Pinellas County and the State of Florida with the opportunity to obtain a workforce diploma. \$1,000,000 will provide approximately 733 FL residents with access to the program.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Activities and Services Provided - Workforce Diploma Scholarships, Transcript Analysis, Academic Instruction, Academic Support, Learning Management System.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Pinellas Public Library Cooperative will provide eligible patrons with an enrollment "scholarship" (direct services) in a workforce diploma program.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is adults in Pinellas County and the State of Florida who are looking to improve employment and earning prospects including, economically disadvantaged and jobless.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increase or improve economic activity--this outcome is measured by total number of workforce diploma graduates and total number of entry level workforce certificates.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The online workforce diploma program shall be available from 7 AM through 10 PM (EST), Monday through Friday. The program shall be available 95% of each month, as verified by an independent monitoring company and reported monthly. Financial consequences in the amount of \$2,500 will be imposed for each month that the vendor's program availability (as reported by the independent monitoring company) drops below 95%; and \$5,000 each month that availability drops below 90%.
