a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose or goal of this project is traffic safety and alleviation of congestion. The turn lanes will allow for safe operation of large commercial vehicles entering and departing SR 82 at this intersection.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will be for the construction of this project. Planning, engineering and design, has already been completed.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Safety will be provided to the citizens with this project. Lee County is in the process of hardening their roads and traffic signals post Hurricane Ian and this project falls in line with many of the other projects being explored. 290 crashes have occurred in this intersection since 2015.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Thousands of vehicles pass through this intersection each day. This intersection has high commercial traffic so this project will help the commercial vehicles and personal vehicles remain safe when passing through.

Reducing the threat of dangerous intersections. Outcomes can be measured by traffic studies and intersection safety data.
