14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

USF's CBCS will establish curriculum as part of a "Leadership in Crisis Recognition and Intervention" (or a similar name TBD) graduate certificate for law enforcement, and especially leadership and commanding officers within law enforcement, to develop and enhance skills in psychological trauma and resilience, mental health awareness and effective interventions, and leadership skills. USF is partnering with the Office of Attorney General Ashley Moody to develop this multiple course graduate certificate which will address some of the most significant issues facing law enforcement leadership with respect to mental health of officers themselves and the public they encounter while performing their duties. Classes may include Criminal Justice Administration, etc.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Course instruction in four core graduate level courses (twelve credit hours) for law enforcement officers to improve leadership skills and specialized trainings. The funds will cover the tuition and fees for each enrolled officer to complete the graduate certificate free of charge to the LEO or their agency until the funds dedicated to scholarships are exhausted.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Course instruction to law enforcement officers at USF in leadership and other skill areas.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Law enforcement officers. > 250 officers annually will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Advanced skills and training for law enforcement officers in graduate level classes that include criminal justice administration, principles of working with various drug using populations and multidimensional assessment methods, treatment setting, modalities and clinical practices and issues of psychological trauma, evidence-based practices, and post traumatic growth and resilience.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Reductions in funding for unmet deliverables.
