14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To complete the 2nd and final phase of the Senate President Jim King Trail in Putnam County in the town of Welaka. Senate President Jim King maintained and owned a house on the St. Johns River for decades and it was frequently used for political gatherings and other events. The 1st phase has already been completed.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The 2nd phase of the Trail will be completed to ensure the safety of the public as they arrive on the Trail and go to the former home of Senate President Jim King which is open to the public. Engineering, asphalting of the road to allow more tourists to visit, to ensure the safety of the public, and to protect run-off into the St. John's River.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The direct services will be the completion of Phase 2 which is to asphalt the current remainder of the Trail to state transportation standards to ensure the safety of the public and to protect the St. John's River. The Town of Welaka will continue to maintain records of whom is visiting and provide any additional assistance that tourists or groups that come to visit may need.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population includes, elderly persons, developmentally disabled persons, physically disabled persons, grade school students, high school students, the general public, tourists, and visitors to the area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The primary benefit will be to enhance the cultural experience. Another benefit will be to recognize Senate President Jim King and the Town of Welaka as the base for his river home, and the history attached to this Trail. In addition, the completion of this 2nd phase will improve groundwater, improve drinking water, improve surface water quality through less run-off into the river, improve stormwater management, and improve wastewater management,
