The purpose is the construction of safety and operational improvements at the intersection of SE Maricamp Road and SE 25th Avenue including installation of an exclusive westbound right turn lane on SE Maricamp Road.

Reconstructing the northbound approach on SE 25th Avenue at SR 464/Maricamp Road to have a left-turn lane, shared left-turn/through lane, and a dedicated right-turn lane; Constructing a westbound right-turn lane on SR 464/Maricamp Road at SE 25th Avenue; and signal retiming.
