#### 4. Project/Program Description

The City of Winter Park, FL has a bridge over Howell Creek which provides for vehicular and pedestrian travel on Stirling Avenue. The existing bridge is approximately 70 years old and consists of two wood box culverts for conveyance of the Howell Creek surface water. The project design calls for the box culverts to be replaced with a single concrete flat slab and reconstruction of the roadway, sidewalks, and railings over the bridge.
