13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

School Districts and state data will have real time clarity on certifications, Career and Technical Student Organizations and work based learning for all the K12 CTE students in FL. Identifying stackable credentials for students as well removing significant work load from district staff. Currently results for certification testing for students results and completion is a paper based system, labor intensive, slow and often delayed. This system eliminates duplicative work required by district staff, allowing CTE teachers to get back in the classroom.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The system provides one stop online digital data collection and reporting platform for each district regarding CTE, certification, where the student is in the process, reports CTSO hours, work base learning hours, inventory management for CTE programs and shares all the data with DOE.

Reports on student demographics, gender, poverty level, ethnicity, any student identifiers, so administrators can find gaps in demographics being served.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

CTE educators, students and administrators will have single environment to collect and manage all information associated with successful completion of CTE data.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

K12 CTE departments. This includes over 500 high schools, and approximately 1.45 million students and over 10,000 educators. (source careertech.org)

Increased insight to CTE course use and completer status as well as clarity on industry based certifications. All measured in the online system with reporting to the district and DOE in near real time.
