The funding is intended to enhance the envelope of the Hertz Arena which is currently utilized by Lee County as a place of refuge during extreme weather events. This will be through the replacement of windows and window systems, doors and door systems, mechanical equipment and louvers that create openings through the facade, and roofing upgrades that will allow the ability to isolate the protected area from the unprotected areas of the arena facility.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Lee County will operate the facility as an emergency shelter.
c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?
Improved safety at evacuation shelter during natural disasters.
d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?
All evacuees who need to use a public shelter during hurricanes or other emergencies.
e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
Protect the general public from harm, The enhancements will be accomplished by replacing the current systems with materials and systems that exceed the current building code requirements for this area. The design parameters are as follows: 180 mph wind speed (Ultimate 3 sec. bursts), Risk Category IV, Importance Factor 1.0 Exposure C, and Interior Pressure Coefficient +/- 0.1.
