a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project goal is to increase access to clean, dry diapers and essential hygiene items for working parents and families with children under the age of 3.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funding will support our Mobile Diaper Distribution program to increase access to diapers and essential hygiene items and improve parents' economic self-sufficiency.

The Central Florida Diaper Bank will provide direct distribution of diapers and essential hygiene resources (e.g., wipes) to parents and families.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will serve working parents and families with infants and toddlers under the age of 3, particularly those from low-income populations. The Central Florida Diaper Bank anticipates serving 4,000 people through this program, which is a conservative estimate.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected outcomes are improved access to diapers and essential child care resources for families. The Central Florida Diaper Bank will monitor the number of diapers distributed on a monthly basis.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

The project will be on a reimbursement basis. Central Florida Diaper Bank will submit invoices to the State for payment as benchmarks are met. Central Florida Diaper Bank will not receive funding if no expenses are incurred.
