a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The requested funds will be used to create, design, plan, construct and operate a high quality World Class Florida Museum of History in the Town of Eatonville. The museum will be a large mufti purpose cultural center with its primary focus being a large world class museum in the Town of Eatonville.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Florida Museum of History in the Town of Eatonville will serve as an education facility, a multi purpose cultural arts and events center, and will serve to attract a large number of the 70 plus million annual visitors to the Orlando - Orange County, Florida area, to the Florida Museum of History in the Town of Eatonville thus driving tourists to the Town of Eatonville, and additional tourists.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Florida Museum of History in the Town of Eatonville will be a multi purpose and multi cultural events center and a world class museum. The museum will provide space for meetings, a 250 seat performing arts theater, a 250-500 person banquet hall, full sized banquet capable kitchen facility, and the Museum of History in the Town of Eatonville will provide a high quality history and education experience.

Over 800 of the target population is expected to be served.
