13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

To revert and reappropriate the project funds to the FY 25-26 budget, to meet the delivery date for the City's High Water Type 3 Fire Engine. This engine will meet the specific needs of Marco Island, and will be capable of responding to fire rescue emergencies during storm surge flooding events where traditional fire engines are unable to operate due to the weather conditions.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

To complete the purchase and receive delivery of the High Water Type 3 Fire Engine, as this equipment will maintain fire rescue protection services to the community during flooding events such as storm surge conditions. Traditional fire apparatus is unable to operate in flood water conditions limiting firefighters ability to safely respond to fires. This vehicle will provide uninterrupted fire rescue response during these type of weather events.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Residents are at significant risk during flooding conditions when firefighters are unable to respond to fire rescue emergencies due to a lack of specific equipment. This vehicle provides firefighters the ability to safely respond and provide the necessary emergency services to protect the residents and visitors of our community during storm events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The residents and visitors of Marco Island represent the target population served by this project. Approximately 20,000 individuals locally will be served. The vehicle will also serve as a county and regional asset serving other communities in need during storm flooding events.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

To revert and reappropriate the project funds to the FY 25-26 budget, to meet the delivery date for the City's High Water Type 3 Fire Engine. Securing this engine will allow firefighters the ability to quickly and safely respond, providing the necessary emergency services to residents and visitors during storm events. The method of measurement will be the ability to safely respond to fire rescue emergencies during flood water incidents within accepted response time parameters achieving rapid fire attack and/or positive patient outcomes.
