In addition, technology assistance will be available to help seniors learn to use computers, tablets, and online communication tools promoting digital inclusion and connectivity.

Outcomes will be measured through participant surveys, comments, and suggestions, which will be used to guide improvements to programming and activities. Economic benefits would be obtain through the local Chamber of commerce and other economic related organizations.
