This intersection has experienced vehicular crashes as well as near-miss incidents exacerbated by the growing student loading at the five-year-old Viera Elementary School. Construction of the intersection improvements will alleviate the traffic concerns at this current all way stop intersection. The project is currently at 100% design and the project is ready to move forward. The County is working with the Brevard County School district to complete the signal project this fiscal year.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Improvements to the intersection will include a fully signalized intersection at Stadium and Cuddington and will include the addition of ADA compliant sidewalks at the intersection crossings.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

By constructing the intersection improvements, roadway users will find the intersection to be a safe mode of transportation for those using motor vehicles, buses, and other modes of transportation such as grade school walkers and bikers as well as parents driving a golf carts.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are those students and general public that are using the intersection to get to school or traverse the roadway at the intersection.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of this project is a safe intersection for both pedestrians, active transportation users, and roadway users. This will be measured by a decrease in traffic incidents at the intersection

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for in the contract?

The County's contracts for construction include comprehensive provisions that address failure to perform, including liquidated damages for not achieving Substantial Completion, and termination. In addition, the County will complete a post-construction evaluation of the contractor and submit the form to the County's Purchasing Services.
