13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

For Florida to protect its economy and maintain its cutting-edge position in university-based hurricane research, innovation, and testing, the highly successful FIU Wall of Wind (WOW) hurricane simulator needs a complementary and more powerful testing facility capable of reaching 195-200 mph wind speeds, together with storm surge, wave, and flood testing capabilities.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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FIU Wall of Wind for Category 6 will research and test the ability of structures, components, products, and techniques to withstand the effects of a Category 6 hurricane or stronger including (a) 195-200 mph winds, (b) surge, wave, and flooding associated with those extreme events, and (c) hurricane-spawned tornadoes.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

There is a critical need for full-scale research and testing facilities capable of simulating extreme conditions and devising test solutions for stronger and safer communities. The research and testing from the facility will enhance preparedness, mitigation, and recovery.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Any Floridian impacted by hurricanes or storm surge. This would serve the millions of citizens living in Florida.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduction of economic losses and fatalities from natural disasters including hurricanes. Post-hurricane assessment to measure reduction in fatalities and insurance claims data for estimating reduction of economic losses. The Florida Public Hurricane Loss Model (FPHLM) can also measure the loss reduction using mitigation techniques
