13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will enhance roadway safety and accessibility for students, residents, and businesses by constructing two modern roundabouts along Menendez Avenue at the intersections of Maggiore Street and Rosaro Avenue. The improvements are particularly critical given the project's proximity (less than one mile) to G.W. Carver Elementary School, Maggiore Park, and the presence of multiple businesses along the US-1 corridor, where safe pedestrian access is essential.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

City will retain the services of a licensed Contractor to construct two modern roundabouts along Menendez Avenue at the intersections of Maggiore Street and Rosaro Avenue.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improves the conditions along Menendez Avenue at the intersections of Maggiore Street and Rosaro Avenue that provide access daily to residents, business owners, and visitors. Will help maintain traffic flow and provide uninterrupted access to critical public services such as emergency fire and police.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Residents, business owners, and commuters. Approximately 49,000 residents and all those that travel through the city to reach other destinations throughout Miami-Dade County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The addition of two roundabouts will enhance roadway safety by realigning the intersections and slowing down traffic. These enhancements will provide safe pedestrian accéss for schoolchildren and families due to its proximity to G.W. Carver Elementary and Maggiore Park. Speed and crash data will be analyzed after construction is complete. Curb ramps will meet ADA standards.
