The requested funds will allow the City of West Melbourne to construct a new, higher-capacity and more resilient industrial injection well to replace reliance on its 40-year-old municipal well. This project will ensure long-term wastewater management capacity, reduce the risk of environmental harm, and protect groundwater resources by preventing system failures and potential contamination during high flow events.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

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The funds requested will support all activities and services necessary to design, construct, and test a new deep industrial injection well, installation of wellheads and valves, and injection testing to ensure reliable, resilient wastewater management.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This important project will provide West Melbourne residents and businesses with reliable and resilient wastewater management, reducing the risk of system failures, environmental contamination, and protecting groundwater resources for the community.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project serves the residents, businesses, and industries of the City of West Melbourne who rely on the municipal wastewater system.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project will provide the City of West Melbourne with a higher-capacity, resilient industrial injection well, ensuring reliable wastewater management, reducing environmental risks, and protecting groundwater resources. Citizens and businesses will benefit from reduced risk of system failures and potential contamination. This will be measured by successful construction and commissioning of the industrial injection well, completion of injection testing to confirm operational capacity, and ongoing monitoring to ensure reliable wastewater disposal and no adverse impact on groundwater quality.
