c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new complex will be a central gathering place that will become the heart of the community. It will feature 12 acres of park space and 4 acres of municipal building(s) that will house the Town Hall, a Police Station, and a Community Center with a Pool.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project serves the general population of the Town of Cutler Bay (Approximately 43,000) and surrounding neighborhoods in South Miami-Dade County.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The project protects public health through the remediation of harmful toxins in the soil. The project allows the Town to develop the property into the "Legacy Park & Municipal Complex" which will be the central hub of the community. It creates a sense of community, increases access to park space, and attracts new business to the Town's Old Cutler Road commercial district. Benefits will be measured by the completion of the project and tracking of events held at the project site along with tracking new businesses through commercial permits.
