13. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The Sarasota Bradenton International Airport has grown over 300% from 1,300,000 to 4,500,000 passengers, thereby necessitating increases in public safety personnel. All dispatch services are handled in a communications facility in terminal which is not hurricane hardened. Airport lost over 100,000 sq ft of roof in last storm and water leaks endangered entire public safety communications. This project would provide a secure, hurricane hardened facility.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction of the facility only. All operational services will be funded by the airport.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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Project would guarantee public safety communications for the entire airport even during the most severe hurricane conditions including Police, Fire and Emergency medical Services and response to mass casualty, active shooter, terrorism and weather emergencies.
