The purpose of this project is to connect Stradley Park to the City of Cocoa's sewer system to replace the existing septic system, which often cannot handle the high demand during community sporting events. This improvement will enhance public health, safety, and environmental protection by eliminating septic overflows. Additionally, extending the sewer connection will support the park's continued growth and ensure reliable infrastructure for future recreational use.

The project will include engineering design, permitting, and construction activities. Services will include installation of new sewer pipelines, potential lift stations, and proper abandonment of the existing septic systems. These improvements will ensure reliable wastewater service for park users and support ongoing recreational activities without interruption.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Funding this project will provide citizens with improved sanitation and reliable wastewater services. It will eliminate septic system failures that can disrupt events, ensuring a cleaner and safer environment for players, families, and visitors. This upgrade will enhance the overall experience at the park by supporting uninterrupted recreational activities and promoting public health.

The general public to include residents in the surrounding communities and throughout Brevard County that utilize that park.
