a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project will support critical capital improvements needed to maintain advanced wastewater treatment (AWT) performance, protect nearshore water quality, and ensure regulatory compliance. The upgrades will enhance treatment reliability, system efficiency, and long-term resiliency for the community.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Activities include design, permitting, bidding, construction, and engineering services during construction. Improvements may involve treatment system upgrades, replacement of aging mechanical and electrical components, enhanced process controls, and other capital improvements necessary to maintain AWT standards and reliable facility operations.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The project will provide residents, visitors, and businesses with reliable, high-quality wastewater treatment that protects the health of the community and the surrounding marine environment. Maintaining AWT performance reduces nutrient loading and helps safeguard the coastal waters that support recreation, tourism, property values, and the City's overall quality of life.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The project will directly serve approximately 525 full-time residents, as well as seasonal residents, tourists, and local businesses that rely on the City's wastewater system. It also benefits the broader community that depends on the Florida Keys' coastal waters for recreation, fishing, tourism, and economic activity.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits include improved treatment reliability, sustained AWT effluent quality, maintain low nutrient discharge, and enhanced environmental protection. Outcomes will be measured through effluent monitoring, Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs), regulatory compliance evaluations, system performance data, and reductions in maintenance issues or treatment disruptions.
